Mission Statement

Mt. Olive Evangelical Lutheran School exists to provide families with knowledge of Jesus as their Savior, train students in all areas of academics, and encourage families in Christian living.

Tuition Facts

Mt. Olive is maintained primarily for the Christian Education of its members. We also find pleasure in offering the truths of God's Word to the unchurched and all those who wish to be a part of our school. For this reason, our church has decided to subsidize students who attend our school. Tuition is charged to help offset the cost of operating our school. This year, the average cost per student in grades K-8 will be about \$5,300. As you compare this with our tuition costs, you will see that the congregation does take a great interest in providing Christian Education.

Tuition Assistance

Mt. Olive School does have a tuition assistance program. Assistance is truly offered in three different ways. The first way is through the subsidy in tuition already covered by the church body. The second is an opportunity for families to reduce their tuition by 5%. They can receive this discount by paying the tuition in full at or before registration night. The third offering of assistance comes in the form of direct money to help make tuition payments. The school has a fund which is supported strictly by volunteer donors. Each year, applications for financial aid are received, and the Christian Education School Committee (CESC) determines how to disperse the donations given to that fund. This source of financial aid is only available as funds are available.

How to Apply

To apply for financial aid, parents need to speak to the principal or secretary to receive a "Financial Aid Application." Just fill out the application **completely** and return it to school. Applications should be completed on or before July 1st. The CESC then meets to award financial aid based on information received as well as funds available. Applications received after July 1st will be considered only if funding is available. Upon review by the CESC, you will be notified as to the amount of aid granted.
