

## FACTS ABOUT TRANSPLANTATION IN THE UNITED STATES

On June 1, 2007, the OPTN National patient waiting list for organ transplant includes the following:

These members are included in both the count of transplant centers and operating OPOs. For this reason, the total number of members is less than the sum of the different categories.
